

Today the Church remembers the 350 holy Fathers of the Seventh Ecumenical Council under Tarasius (February 25). the holy Patriarch

The Synod of 787, the second to meet at Nicea, refuted the Iconoclast heresy during the reign of Empress Irene and her son Constantine VI.

The Council decreed that the veneration of icons was not idolatry (Exodus 20:4-5), because the or paint, but passes to the prototype (the person depicted). It also upheld the possibility of de-

According to honor shown to them is not directed to the wood the Slavic menaion, however, if the eleventh falls on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, the service is moved to the preceding Sunday.






